### **CALCULATION STANDARDS TABLE OF COMMERCIAL EXPERIMENTS AND RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT TELECOMMUNICATIONS FREQUENCY**

Assigned bandwidth(BW)	Calculation Formula(per license for the establishment and operation of network)
$BW \leq 25 \text{ kHz}$	NT\$ 1,650
$25 \text{ kHz} < BW \leq 500 \text{ kHz}$	NT\$ 2,750
$500 \text{ kHz} < BW \leq 10 \text{ MHz}$	NT\$ 22,000
$10 \text{ MHz} < BW \leq 20 \text{ MHz}$	NT\$ 42,350
$20 \text{ MHz} < BW$	NT\$ 62,150

Remarks:

1. The assigned bandwidth (BW) includes the uplink and downlink bandwidth.
2. The assigned bandwidth of different frequency bands shall be combined and calculated.
3. The utilization fee of radio frequency shall be charged once when the license for the establishment and operation of network is issued or renewed. The frequency period shall six months, and Article 3 of the standard shall not apply.
4. During the term of license for the establishment and operation of network, in cases of where a license is replaced due to change of frequency, the utilization fee shall be calculated, before the replacement of license, according to the calculation standard of original utilization fee of radio station; after the replacement of license, according to the calculation standard of utilization fee after change.
5. After the utilization fee has been paid, in cases where a license for the establishment and operation of network is revoked or abolished by NCC, the utilization fee calculated based on the number of days from the day which the license is revoked or abolished until the expiration day of the original license shall be refunded by NCC without interest.
6. Frequency user, within 30 days from the next day of the license for the establishment and operation of network issuance, shall pay the utilization fee annually in the form of cash, check issued by bank, treasury check, or bill of exchange, or wire transfer through a financial institution; Article 4 of the standard shall not apply.
7. The aforementioned check, treasury check or bill of exchange shall be made payable to the NATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION.
